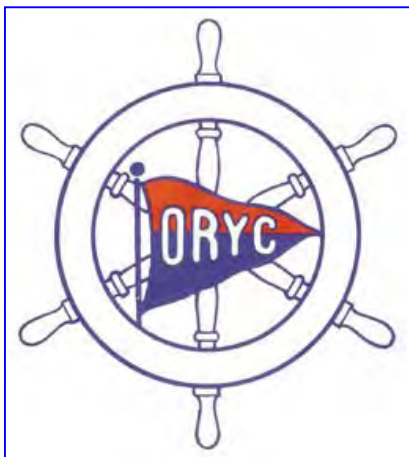

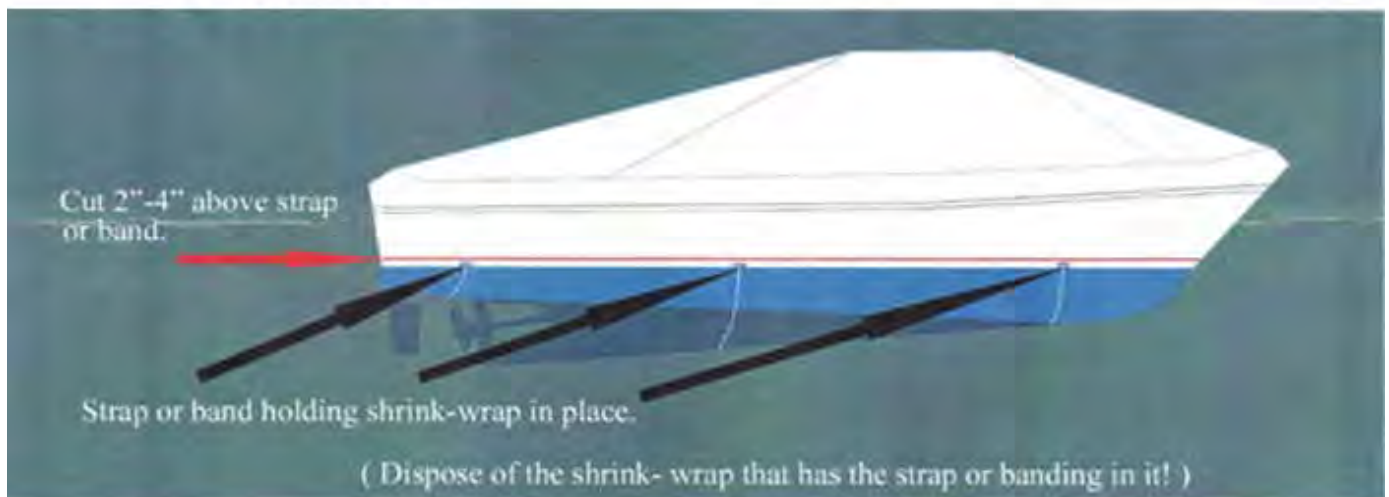

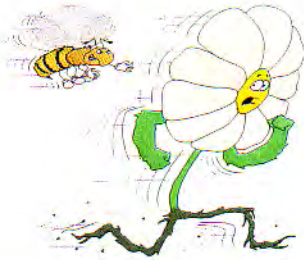

Cattail Regatta Schedule of Events:

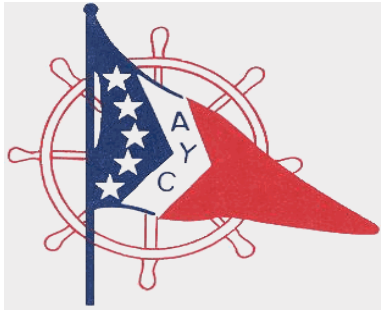
0800 – 1100: Registration, Rigging and Launching.

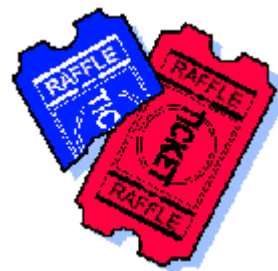
