A special note out to Member Pete Bailey for the extra attention to the electrical panel and parts he donated at the Regatta. Thanks Pete!!

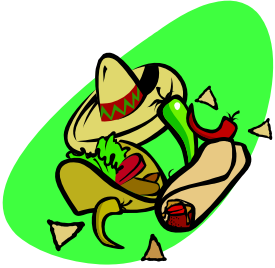


I had the privilege of attending a Commodores reception at NCYC and fundraiser for 2008 Gold medalist Anna Tunnicliffe.
